Quindew's Reading Growth Reports showcase reading achievement by students in grades 3-12 who learned with Quindew for two Seasons or more during a school year.



NATIONAL GROWTH FOR MIDDLE LEVEL 2021-2022

Middle school students grades 6-8 who learned on Quindew made significant growth during the 2021-2022 school year. Students who were identified as being moderately and highly engaged and who completed more than three seasons excelled beyond their peers.

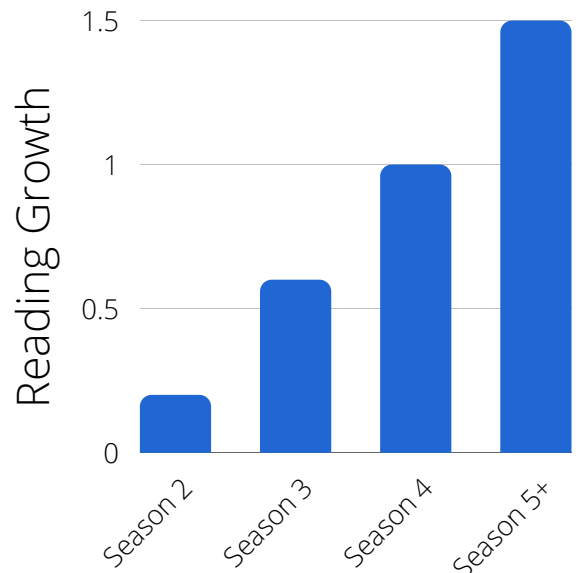
QUINDEW ASSESSMENTS

Quindew's adaptive reading assessments measure deep reading comprehension skills, vocabulary, and rhetorical reading skills like analyzing author's purpose, word choice, and text structure. Quindew's assessments are embedded in the reading lessons. Assessments happen alongside learning, so valuable instructional time isn't lost.

Students' minds are always actively engaged on Quindew because a missed question becomes an opportunity to learn and get stronger as a reader with our second chance opportunities. And our results show that engaged students produce better, more accurate reading data.

Quindew's embedded assessments ask students to identify details in a text like they would during classroom instruction. Students answer rigorous questions by marking textual details or typing words and phrases. Every decision students make becomes part of the data that tells a clearer story about who students are as readers. Quindew truly measures knowledge because students cannot guess from a list of multiple choice answers.

Quindew's data, when compared to NWEA MAP RIT, PARCC, SBAC, and iReady scores, are statistically correlated and can reliably predict how a student will perform on these types of national reading tests.

Middle schools across the United States partnered with Quindew to support the teaching and evaluation of deep reading comprehension skills during the 2021-2022 school year. Quindew successfully strengthened students' confidence as readers and improved performance on state and local reading assessments. Teachers who assigned 2-3 Quests each week, targeted learning gaps with Quindew's Clarity Data and Curriculum Pack, and celebrated students' achievements saw significant growth.

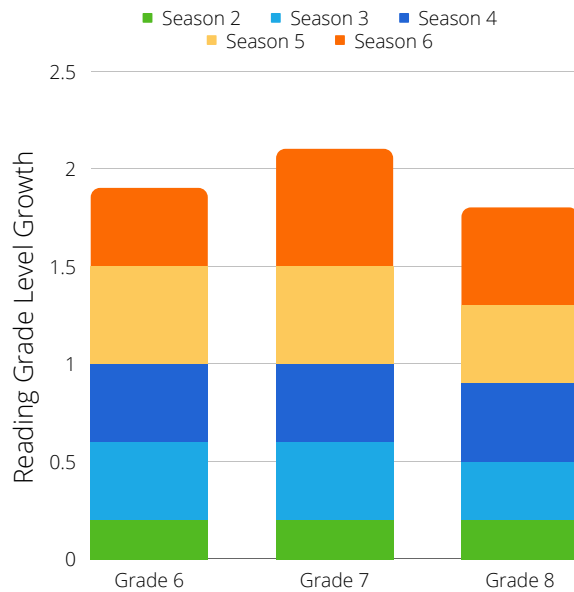
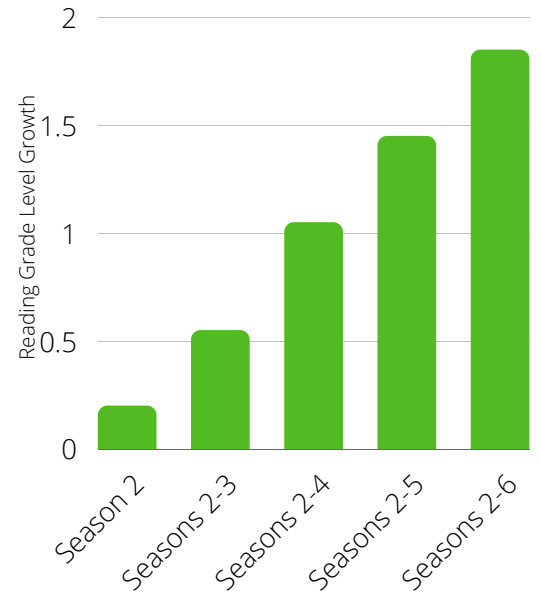

OVERALL READING GROWTH

Middle school students who learned on Quindew made considerable growth during the 2021-2022 school year. Students who were identified as being moderately and highly engaged and who completed more than three seasons showed the greatest reading growth.

Middle school students who read on Quindew consistently reported to have more confidence as readers. They increased their time on task, improved their reading fluency, and strengthened their deep reading comprehension skills.



GROWTH BY GRADE

Middle school students in grades 6-8 continued to grow on Quindew each Season. As they progressed through the Seasons, students grew nearly half a grade level. Students who finished Season 6 (or 72 Quests) grew substantially more than students who completed 2 or fewer Seasons.

The graph on the left details how grade level groups grew on average over 6 Seasons.

SUMMARY OR ENGAGEMENT

Engagement is a key metric for Quindew and our school/district partners. If students are not engaged in an assessment, the data is most likely inaccurate and should not be trusted. Disengaged students are at a higher risk of getting bored and giving up on an assessment. This is why tracking engagement is so critical to our work.

Quindew's engagement algorithm measures students' engagement during each question. At the end of a Quest (or reading lesson), Quindew calculates engagement. In the 2021-2022 school year, 96% of middle school students were highly engaged and doing their best while learning on Quindew.
